



BY-LAW APPROVED AND MINUTED ON 5th AUGUST 2010 AND IS APPLICABLE FROM 5th AUGUST 2010 GOVERNING THE CODE OF CONDUCT OF JUNIORS AND THE ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARENTS/GUARDIANS.

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The By-laws as contained herein are authorised by the Committee of the Association.
- 1.2 The Committee derives its powers to introduce the By-laws pursuant to Clause 16.1[c] in the Rules of the Association applicable from the 28th February 2007.
- 1.3 The definitions used in these By-laws are based on the Rules of the Association.

2 CODE OF CONDUCT OF JUNIORS AND THE ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARENTS/GUARDIANS

DTBA wishes to operate in an environment where all members show respect for others and their property. Respect is defined as consideration for another's physical and emotional well being and possessions, to ensure no damage or deprivation is caused to either.

This Code of Conduct applies specifically to DTBA's Junior members as defined in our Rules of Association:

2.1 Responsibilities of Junior members in DTBA

- 2.1.1 Junior members will always play by the rules and will not argue with DTBA officials (e.g. Supervisors/Committee members).
- 2.1.2 Junior members will control their temper and refrain from verbal abuse, inappropriate behaviour and offensive language.
- 2.1.3 Junior members will treat other players with respect.
- 2.1.4 Junior members will wear appropriate sports attire/clothes and non-marking sports shoes.



2.2 Responsibilities of Parent(s) or Guardian

- 2.2.1 Encourage their child/children to play within the rules and respect DTBA official's decisions.
- 2.2.2 Refrain from using abusive language or harass any person (including DTBA officials) in DTBA.
- 2.2.3 Will be responsible for the safety and well-being of child (children) who are non-members of DTBA
- 2.2.4 Will not interfere or get involved in the operation of the junior session unless requested to do so.

2.3 General Responsibilities

- 2.3.1 DTBA is a non smoking, non alcohol sporting club and these restrictions will have to be strictly adhered to.
- 2.3.2 Consumption of food and drinks is only permitted in the confines of the tea room and not in the playing area.
- 2.3.3 All soft drinks (cans) must be paid for in full before removing from fridge.
- 2.3.4 No gambling of any kind will be permitted in DTBA premises.
- 2.3.5 Payment for each social session must be made prior to entering the playing courts.

2.4 Breach of Code of Conduct (COC)

If a junior member breached our COC we will advise the parents in writing, providing details of the breach. If this junior member persists in breaching our COC we will then reserve the right to disallow this person from participating in future social sessions for juniors.
